- 5 Josephine ____: an African saint who was captured by Arab slave traders in the 19th century; her feast day is on February 8.
- 7 Our Lady appeared near this town in France in 1858.
- 8 This saint is mentioned in the Roman Canon of the Mass; she was martyred in Sicily around the year 253.
- 10 This saint was the brother of St. Methodius.
- 11 Our Lady of clue #7 appeared to this saint.

- 1 The last name of Francisco and Jacinta, two of the seers of Fatima; their feast day is February 20.
- 2 The feast of Paul ____ and his companions is celebrated on February 6; they were martyred in Japan in 1597.
- 3 She was the sister of St. Benedict.
- 4 This saint was martyred in the third century; many people give cards to their loved ones on his feast day.
- 6 His feast day is February 3rd in the Latin Rite.
- 9 At Mass on February 3rd, one can receive a special blessing of this part of the body.
